Hitler notably attended performances of the Burg Theater until his departure from Vienna in 1913. In April 1908, Hitler and his friend August Kubizek attended a performance of Goethe's *Otello*. On March 12, 1909, the building of the Theater was seriously damaged during a fire that destroyed the roof.

From September - November 1909, a destitute Hitler resided at this address and applied for admission to the hospital. He was rejected for his lack of financial resources.
